Dr. Raza has been elected for his outstanding contributions to the Stem Cell Biology & Neuroscience. The elected Fellows are given the designation of Fellow of the Royal Society of Biology (FRSB).

Dr. Raza is also currently serving as an Assistant Dean of the Faculty of Basic Medical Sciences, Era University. His research interest is in translational (Stem Cell and Nanotechnology) therapy for stroke recovery. Dr. Raza has been associated with the Indian Academy of Neuroscience as a Life-Member since 2009.

For the last ten years, he is working in the field of stroke research and regenerative medicine. He is mainly interested in elucidating how best to utilize stem cell and nanoparticle therapy to treat ischemic stroke. Noteworthy, in the recent past he has been conferred with various prestigious awards, notably, the International Brain Research Organisation Young Scientist Award, Japan Neuroscience Society Travel Award, Indian Academy of Biomedical Sciences Neuroscience Award, IBRO-APRC Fellowship, and Council for Scientific Industrial and Research Fellowship, to name a few. He has recently been elected as a lifetime member of the National Academy of Sciences India, the oldest scientific academy supported by the Department of Science & Technology to cultivate and promote science and technology. He is on the editorial board of several prestigious journals of international repute. He has published more than thirty-five publications in the peer-reviewed international journal and co-authored a couple of book chapters.
